Montgomery ISD has applied for a class size exception to the 22 to 1 student/teacher ratio for K-4th grade. At submission time, MISD had one K-4th grade class above 22.
- Contract Extensions and Renewals for Administrators
Normal MISD procedures are to annually act on certain administrator's contracts in February. Due to the state budget crisis, MISD decided to postpone this action until the 82nd Legislative Session was complete. After receiving the final dollar amount of cuts from the state, MISD approved a reduced balanced budget in August and acted on the above mentioned contracts in September.
- Probationary Contract for Coordinator of Testing and Special Programs
Montgomery ISD hired Mrs. Sheryl Burlison as our new Coordinator of Testing and Special Programs. Mrs. Burlison will be replacing the retiring Mrs. Sarah Hilburn. Mrs. Burlison's anticipated arrival date is November 1st.
