Our ratings are derived from student performance passing rates beginning at third grade through grade eleven on state mandated tests in Reading, English Language Arts, Writing Mathematics, Science and Social Studies.

The Standard Calculation and the Texas Projection Measure Calculation

- Under the standard method of calculation, a rating is based on the number of students passing a TAKS test divided by the total number of students taking the same TAKS test.
- The Texas Projection Measure is an estimate of whether a student is likely to pass a TAKS test in a future grade. After Required Improvement has been evaluated, the TPM is applied to determine if the campus/district can achieve a higher rating. A rating under TPM is based on the number of students passing a TAKS test plus the number of students failing, (but had shown sufficient improvement to meet the TPM) divided by the total number of students taking the same TAKS test.
- Exemplary= 90% student passing rate, Recognized= 80%, and Academically Acceptable= Depends on Exam Given 55%-70% passing rate.
