Montgomery ISD's Child Nutrition Department is pleased to announce that our convenient secure online meal account prepayment system now offers additional services.

## To access these services:

1. Simply go to the district web site at [www.misd.org](http://www.misd.org).
2. Click on MyNutrikids.com link. From this site you will create your account and add money to your child's school meal account. All you need is your child's name, student ID number, and school ZIP code. The instructions listed on this page will guide you through the easy online account set up process.

## New services:

- If you have more than one child in the District, you can handle all online prepayments from the same online account with only one flat fee of \$1.75 instead of paying 4% of the deposited amount for each child.
- Payments are generally processed within 24 hours.
- You will be able to print out a copy of your recent purchases online via a history report which lists all dates and times of breakfast and/or lunch purchases within the past thirty days. You will no longer have to contact the Child Nutrition Office to email you this information.
- Later this fall parents and students will be able to access MyNutrikids.com with nutritional information on each product offered in the school cafeteria.

## Add Students to Your Family Account:

1. After clicking on the MyNutrikids.com link, click on the button that says sign up here if you are a new user; if you have already signed up then continue with your user name and password.
2. Enter School District zip code and continue.
3. Follow all required fields and continue.
4. When you log in you will be taken to the homepage.
5. Click **MyKids** from the main menu OR from the blue navigation bar above.
6. This is a listing of the students in your account. It will be empty on your first visit to the site.
7. Click **Add Child** and enter the required information.
8. Click **Add** (next to your child's name) to continue.
9. Click **Add Child** to repeat the process for additional children.
10. NOTE: Your child's transaction history report will not display information during the initial account set up process.

### How to Make a Deposit:

- Click **Deposit Money** located next to **Add Student**.
- Enter an amount in the **Deposit** column next to your child's name. \*\*If you have more than one child, enter the amount you wish to deposit into the column next to each child's name. DO NOT deposit money for your entire family into ONE child's account.
- Click **Calculate**.
- Click **Make Deposit**.
- You will be directed to the PayPal web site to enter your payment information. \*You have the option to use you existing PayPal account or a major credit card to make your payment. If you are using your PayPal account, enter your email address and PayPal password to continue. If you are using a credit card, enter the required information. For your protection, MyNutrikids.com will not store your financial information.
- Click **Pay Now** when finished.
- Click **Pay** once again to finish the process.

We are very excited to offer these new services. Although we realize there is a slight inconvenience by changing from one online payment company to another, we believe the additional services and convenience of handling all family members during one online transaction is worth the transition.

If you choose not to take advantage of the online prepayment service, you may continue to make meal account advance payments via cash or check at your local school cafeteria. Checks should be made payable to MISD Child Nutrition. Please write your **child's full name** and **student ID** on the check. If you pay with cash, be sure the school cafeteria has the information attached to the cash or on the envelope.
