



Montgomery ISD's Child Nutrition Department wants to announce that every parent can be informed on your child's meal account. Low balance alerts will be e-mailed to your primary e-mail address when your child's balance falls below an amount that you specify. This service will also enable you to view purchase history within the past thirty days. To access this service, just follow the steps below:

To access:

- Go to the district web site at www.misd.org
- Click on **MyNutrikids.com** at the left of your screen under Quick Links.
- Click on **Sign up Now** to create your children's meal account.
- Type the ZIP code of the District School, and click on the **Search** button.
- Choose your child's District School (Montgomery I.S.D.) from the drop down menu.
- Enter parent's name.
- Enter e-mail address.
- Create your password.
- Click on **Create Account**
- A confirmation's notification will appear to verify your information.
- Click on **Create Account** again.
- You will receive an automatic answer that your account has been created successfully.
- Click on [here](#) to begin using MyNutrikids.com
- Go to **Account Login**.
- Enter your e-mail address and password.
- Click on **Log-In**
- Click on **Profile** at the top of your screen.
- Click on **Edit Family List** at the left of your screen.
- Click on **Add Child**.
- Enter student ID number.
- Enter initial of child's first name.
- Enter initial of child's last name.
- Click on **Search**.
- MyNutrikids will confirm your child's information.
- Click on **Add Child** again to save the information.
- If you have additional children click on **Add Child** again, and follow the same procedure.
- Click on **Balance Alerts** at the left of your screen.
- Turn Alert Status column **ON** for each child from the drop down menu.
- Enter a specified amount. (You will be notified by email when your child's balance reaches this amount.)
- Click on **Update**.
- Click on **Main Menu**, and **logout** from your account.
