Dear Montgomery ISD Parents,

In driving around the Montgomery area, it is easy to see the development that is taking place, the homes that are being built and the businesses coming to our community. With this growth, there is no surprise that our enrollment in Montgomery ISD is also on the rise.

This past fall, the Montgomery ISD Board of Trustees authorized the formation of a Community Bond Task Force Committee. This committee consisted of over 50 individuals, including parents and staff from each of our ten campuses, community members, and business owners, with district staff available to present information, answer questions and facilitate meaningful and necessary conversation. The committee held six meetings during the fall semester to evaluate district facilities, district growth patterns and projections, our MISD Pathway to Premier Strategic Plan and more.

After two of the six meetings, it was unanimously agreed upon by the committee that MISD will need additional capacity and educational facilities to serve current students enrolled in our district, as well as the thousands more projected to enroll over the next several years. The Community Bond Task Force spent the next four of their meetings developing a bond proposal to present to the Montgomery ISD Board of Trustees at their regularly scheduled board meeting on January 18.

Once the bond proposal is presented to the board, trustees will then vote at their February meeting on whether to call for a bond referendum, which would be on the May 2022 election ballot. If they do so, an election will take place in May of this year that will determine the future of our district.

In our continued effort to be transparent and give our families, staff and community the opportunity to ask questions and receive answers, we have scheduled two Bond Town Hall meetings on January 26 at Montgomery HS and February 2 at Lake Creek HS, both scheduled in the campus auditoriums from 6:00-7:30 p.m.

These meetings will provide you with information that was utilized by the committee to assist in their decision and finalize a bond proposal. The proposal will be shared and attendees will be given the opportunity to learn and ask questions.
